This week 4C had a fantastic first swimming lesson. All of the children were able to demonstrate their swimming skills and had lots of fun. Year 5 have been exploring and learning about strong emotions in PSHEE and how to manage them in a healthy manner. Discussions in class have been very interesting allowing children to express their views using their remarkable oracy skills. Focus Provision have had a busy week completing tasks relating to our Talk Through story of the week 'Oliver's Vegetables'. They have planted onions and peas, talked about healthy eating and made pizzas with peppers, onions and sweetcorn for toppings. All of the children tried hard with chopping the peppers - well done everyone! In Science, Year 2 have enjoyed learning about hygiene and handwashing by experimenting with hand soap and pepper. The children really enjoyed watching the microbes (pepper) move when they added a soapy finger to their water. The experiment really highlighted the importance of handwashing! Year 6 have focused on the environment in geography, they particularly enjoyed delving into the fascinating world of minerals. Nursery have enjoyed learning about bears with familiar and new stories.
