Year 5 Autumn Term Curriculum		How you can support learning at home
Reading	Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo	Ask your child questions about the book (e.g. characters, plot, theme)
Writing	SVGP focus for Autumn term I.  Non-chronological report, character and setting description, narrative poem.	Encourage the children to explore interesting vocabulary, which they can share with us in school  Can they remember the different types of nouns and verbs?
Maths	Place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication and division and practions	Regularly encourage your child to play Times Tables Rockstars — at least 21 minutes per week!
History	Anglo-Saxons	Visit your local library to research any areas of the Anglo-Saxons that your child is particularly interested in
Geography	Changes in our local environment	Can you identify any human and physical features of your local area?
Science	Forces and Properties of materials	Explore the mass and weight of different items within the home — maybe whilst cooking?
Arł	Sculpture and 3D	Can you research any famous sculptures or find any sculptures in your local area?
D.T	Electrical systems - Doodlers	Explore what makes a series circuit — can you name the components?
R.E	Hinduism — Why do Hindus want to be good?  Community - What will make Sandwell a more respectful community?	Ask your child what they have been learning about in Hinduism and the festival of Diwali
Music	Famous composers and exploring styles of music	Ask your child who their famous music artist is and explore various styles of music
Compuling	Lego Coding Project Flat-File databases	Explore the app 'Scratch'
P. E	Outdoor - iPractise (resilience, persistence and personal best), Indoor — Swimming or pilates	Practice throwing, catching, balance and endurance skills.
French	Seasons and Food	Can your child remember the four seasons in French?
PSHEE	Families and Friendships Sape Relationships Respecting Ourselves and Others	Can your child name the five British values?
