Children's Responsibilities

- Read with your child regularly at home and comment in your child's individual reading record.
- Ensure homework is completed on time.
- Help your child with their homework encouraging them to try to their best and providing prompts or support when necessary
- Encourage your children's learning through extra-curricular activities and independent learning i.e. trips to the library or online research for a topic.
- Inform school of any change in your child's circumstances or if you have any concerns regarding any aspect of your child's schooling.
- Inform school of any changes to your contact information such as telephone numbers, addresses etc.
- Try to support school and your child by participating in any meetings, workshops or activities that the school requests for you to attend.
